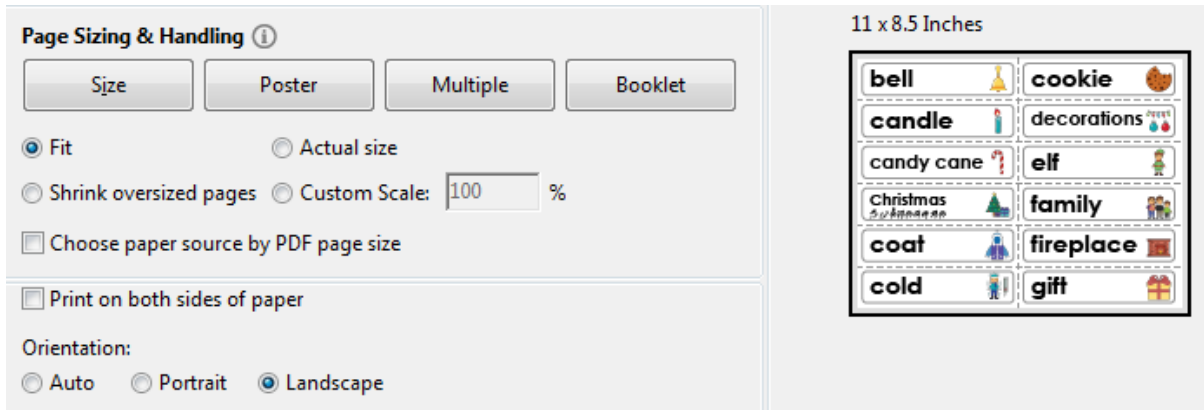


ASL Word Wall - Printing Instructions

1. We recommend printing on card stock or thicker paper to make the cards stiffer and more durable. Laminate the pages if desired for added protection.
2. Ensure the pages are printed **single-sided**, with a **landscape** orientation.



4. Cut along the dotted lines.
5. Place the cards on your ASL word wall or in a pocket chart to increase vocabulary and encourage student independence in writing!

The asterisk () beside a word in the master wordlist indicates alternate hand-shape or finger spelling.
